

directed drawings


Hello! .. and THANK YOU for purchasing this directed drawing unit.

The materials I suggest are: pencils, White drawing paper, Sharpies, and colored pencils. {That's all!}




I also occasionally use wiggly/googly eyes!



how to draw a labybug




























how to draw a Caterpillar
